Only 20 vendors will be selected, and will be reviewed on a first-submitted basis. The Event team will make selections based on diverse products and offerings. (I.e., limited spots for like items, such as baked good, slime, etc.) Tables and chairs will once again be provided. Approved vendors are welcome to bring their own pop-up tent, table coverings, etc. All vendors will receive an email by Sept. 16 regarding the status of their application. If your application is approved for participation, you will receive a Vendor Packet containing:
